This class is to help you have a better understanding of common stabilizers that are used in the bag making world as well as smaller crafting projects. If you purchased the kit you are ready for the class! **If you are opting out of the kit, be sure to remember your results may be different than Boki's during the class. You will need to create your own.**

If you would like to make your own, this is what you will need:

Stabilizers In the Kit:	(Quantity) & Size
SF568 Single Sided Fusible Featherweight	(3) 5"x5"
Decovil Light	(3) 5"x5"
71F Peltex Single Sided Fusible	(3) 5"x5"
Bosal Single Sided Fusible Foam	(3) 5"x5"
Fusible Fleece 987FP Single Sided Fusible	(3) 5"x5"
SF-101 Single Sided Fusible	(3) 5"x5"
Fabrics in Kits:	(Quantity) & Size
100% Quilting Cotton Preferably Solid	(6) 5"x5"
100% Cotton Canvas	(6) 5"x5"
Pliable Faux Leather such as Sallie Tomato	(6) 5"x5"

During this class be sure to take lots of notes! There will be no homework as this will be a collective hands on experience. We will:

- Fuse stabilizers together
- Understand what each stabilizer is best for
- Compare the samples among one another
- Talk about needle recommendations
- Talk about what feet will be helpful while sewing certain fabric/stabilizer combinations.
